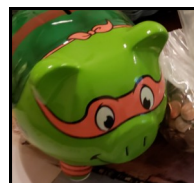

Dear Sisters,

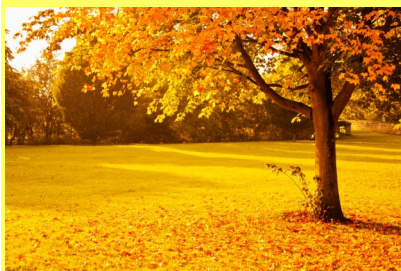
